We are so excited about this year's student celebration called Prom and are looking forward to an evening of friendship, fun and fancy feet. ☺ This document provides the dress and behavior guidelines for this amazing event and needs to be read and signed by each attendee (EN **and** non-EN members) and their parent(s).

Dress Code:

- Gentlemen – Tuxedo or suit
- Ladies – Long dresses preferred. *If you choose to wear a short dress, the shortest part of the hem should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. **Because we love our students, all ladies' dresses must be approved in advance.***
 - We want you to have the dress you love, and we are here to help you determine its appropriateness for an EN event. Here are some guidelines: Dresses may NOT have: Deep plunging necklines, cutouts, or skin colored fabrics under lace (some fabrics under lace are obviously not skin color, but if the dress is made to look like you are naked under the lace, it will not be approved). The dresses may not be strapless. The back must not be lower than the shoulder blades (bra-line).
 - Quite often, your favorite dress may be altered to accommodate the dress code. If your dress is strapless, please add straps. If the bodice shows cleavage, the back dips too low, has cut-outs on the sides, or a slit on the hem that comes above the knee, then please plan to add opaque fabric that matches the dress or stitch fabric closed so that your gorgeous dress complies with dress code. We would love to see you wear it!
 - To ensure that all dresses are appropriate, each dress must be approved by Mrs. Lisa June. **Please text a picture of the front and the back of you in the dress for approval to 678-643-2421.** This applies to all ladies in attendance, EN members and their guests.

Behavior:

- Please be on your best behavior for the night. We want to leave a good impression as Christians and as homeschoolers. Improprieties such as drinking any alcoholic beverages (before or during), smoking, cursing, BEING DISRESPECTFUL, open and blatant public displays of affection and any type of substance abuse will not be tolerated. The chaperones have the right to determine any other issues.
- NO ONE is to leave the Prom area. You cannot go out alone to unattended areas for any reason. You are not to be anywhere at Prom alone with your date/friends at any time. Once you choose to leave the venue, you will not be permitted to return.
- If a chaperone finds you doing anything not permitted, you and the ENTIRE PARTY that was brought by the EN member will be asked to leave and not return. If you are an underclassman (Junior or below) you may lose the opportunity to attend future proms with EN.

Required Form and Liability:

It is our desire to provide a safe and enjoyable evening, so we are requiring that each student who is attending the prom fill out this form. Please provide emergency contact information for each student attending the Prom – to be able to reach parents/emergency contacts by phone at ANY TIME during the evening in case of an emergency. Please include home and cell phone numbers for all responsible adult parties. Parents, we understand that by you allowing your student to attend Prom, your student is licensed to drive OR will be transported by a parent-approved transportation provider such as your student's escort, a pre-approved parent or a limousine service. Please note that Prom is over at 11:00, which should allow all under-18 drivers time to get home before curfew. Eagle's Nest will not be held liable for any transportation issues OR breaking of curfews by underage drivers, so please be sure to make appropriate arrangements.

Eagle's Nest is not responsible for students once they leave the Prom venue; after-prom activities, if any, are independent of the Prom.

Please be aware that music played at the prom/dances may not be Christian music. Most will be dance music played on secular radio that the students request and can dance to. However, the songs will be screened in advance to minimize potential offense.
