

ENCHEA Field Trip Descriptions 2021-2022

Event: Wild Animal Safari

- **Date:** Friday, September 24, 2021 at 11:30 AM
- **Location:** 1300 Oak Grove Rd, Pine Mountain, GA
- **Cost:** \$22 adults/\$17.50 students (Food is an additional \$2.50/cup)
- **Masks:** required inside/not required outside
- **Payment Due:** 9/10/21
- **Description:** ***You have to pay for food to feed the animals in advance (\$2.50/cup). Please include money for food and the number of cups of food you are purchasing on your payment slip*** Wild Animal Safari features two different ways of seeing many exotic animals. The Serengeti Adventure is a 3-mile drive through section where you will have a chance not only to see, but also to feed and touch animals from around the world. Designed to embrace a natural open setting, the drive will bring you face to face with animals such as giraffes, zebras, buffalo, camels, a rhino and many more. There is also a walk-through section where you will see even more exotic animals.

Event: Floating Classroom – 3rd grade and under

- **Description:** Join us as we explore the plants and animals that live in and around West Point Lake. Instructors will help students identify local species, measure air and water temperature, observe birds using binoculars and use hand lenses for magnifying natural objects. Part of this field trip will be on a boat on the lake.

- **Description:** An intermediate program suited for most ages, we'll explore the history, ecology and challenges facing West Point Lake and the Chattahoochee River. Onboard the floating classroom, students will conduct water monitoring to determine pH and dissolved oxygen levels in the lake, measure the turbidity of the water and view plankton samples using microscopes.
