



Student Council Duties and Responsibilities



Eluminatus high school elects a new student council each year. This is done by holding student council elections in which students can make posters to promote their running for a position on the student council. Once elections are over, the student council will meet at least once per month to plan spirit days, high school events, and high school dances. Some of these may be open to all of Eagles Nest and some may be open to only Eluminatus high school students and/or middle school students. Students may be permitted at times to invite non-EN friends to certain events (i.e., a dance).

As a student Council member your duties would include, but are not limited to the following:

- Attend monthly meetings
- Work with the Student Council adult coordinator
- Decide on spirit days (1 per month)
- Decide on event ideas - minimum of 4 per year
 - Announce events a minimum of 2.5 – 3 weeks before the scheduled event
 - Create a sign up for the event using Signup Genius; include event cost per person and how to pay for the event
 - Decide of students will be allowed to invite non-EN friends to the event (i.e., a dance)
- Promote events
 - Talk with friends
 - Flyers
 - Weekly posts to the Eluminatus and ENCHEA Groups.io
- Help with set up and clean up at events
 - Tables/Chairs
 - Food/Drink tables
 - Decorate if needed
- Make sure all students at events are welcomed and included
 - Door greeters
